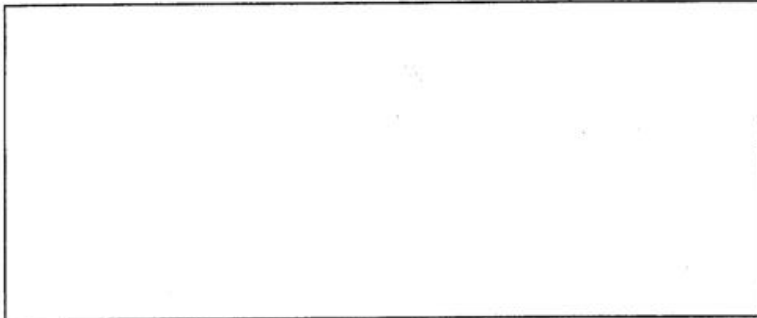

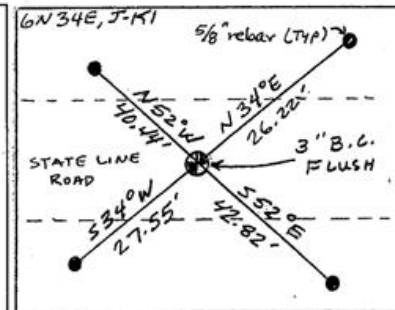

New Accessories: WE SET:

A 5/8 rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped 'Tomkins Surveying' which bears N 34° E ~ 26.22 feet from the corner. Set steel t-post along side and attached a Umatilla County Bearing Object Sign. A 5/8 rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped 'Tomkins Surveying' which bears S 52° E ~ 42.82 feet from the corner. Attached a Umatilla County Bearing Object Sign to an existing Rail Road Tie Fence Post. A 5/8 rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped 'Tomkins Surveying' which bears S 34° W ~ 27.55 feet from the corner. Attached a Umatilla County Bearing Object Sign to 4"x4" post with existing Bearing Sign. A 5/8 rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped 'Tomkins Surveying' which bears N 52° W ~ 40.44 feet from the corner. Set steel t-post along side and attached a Umatilla County Bearing Object Sign.

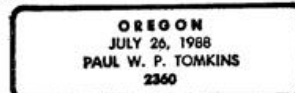
