 General Description.

The land in this Township is rough and mountainous with the exception of a small strip of bottom land, from 5 to 15 chains wide along Meacham creek. The soil is 2nd & 3rd rate, being very stony in places.

The southern part of the Tp. is heavily timbered with pine, fir and tamarack of good quality; the timber in the northern part is more scattering.

Water is quite scarce and the Tp. is principally valuable for its timber.

There is a settler in Sec. 13, whose improvements I could not locate from any point on my lines.
