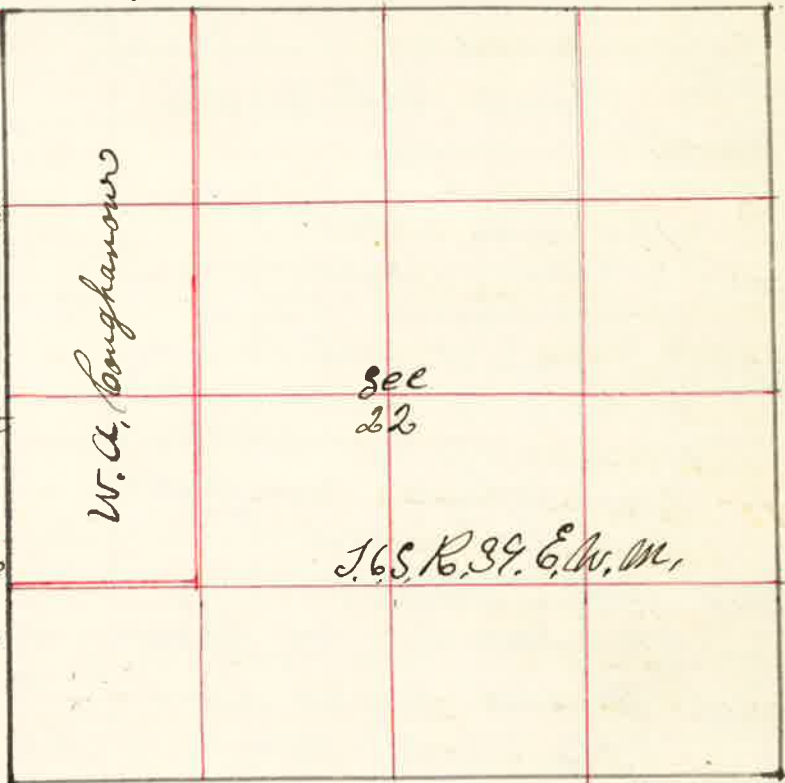

The corner to Sec 17=18=19 & 20 and 19 & 20=29 & 30 and 20=21=28 & 29 and the 1/4 Sec corners between Sec 17 & 2 and 19 & 21 and 20 & 21 and 20 & 29 and 19 & 30 and 19 & 21 being out of place or lost and obliterated, before commencing the survey I proceeded to re-establish the same as per instructions from the Hon. Commissioners of the General Land Office to U.S. Deputy S. as follows to wit:

I commenced at the S.W. corner Sec 19 on public meridian a mound pits & c.
