The Northwest Quarter (N. W. ¼) of Section 13 Township 2 North Range 27 East W. M. Beginning at Station 553+36 of the Butter Creek Highway Survey which Station is approximately 60 feet east of the Section Corner which is common to Sections 11, 12, 13 and 14 Township 2 North Range 27 East W. M. Thence running in a Southwesterly direction approximately 107 feet to Station 554+43 of the said survey, which Station is approximately 87 feet south of the Section corner which is common to Sections 11, 12, 13 and 14 Township 2 North Range 27 East W. M. Contains 0.15 acres more or less.

On Here and in Hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
