the East half of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter, Of Section 17 Township 3 North, Range 28 East W.M.

Beginning at Station 179/25 of the Butter Creek Highway survey which Station is approximately 805 feet East of quarter Corner

which is common to Sections 8 and 17 Township 3 North Range 28 East W.M.

Thence South 19° 18' ^W approximately 175 feet to Station 181/00 of

the said survey, which Station is approximately 175 feet South and 755 feet East of the quarter corner which is common to Sections 8 and 17 Township 3 North Range 28 East W.M. Contains 0.25 acres more or less.
