Known as the Butter Creek Highway Unit No. 1.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Adeline Slusher, formerly Addie Temple, and William Alvah Slusher, her husband, of the County of Umatilla in the State of Oregon, in consideration of the benefits and other valuable consideration, and the sum of one dollar paid to them, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and in further consideration of the promise and agreement of the grantee herein to build fences and to do the other things hereinafter mentioned, have bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit:

A strip of land Sixty (60) feet wide, being Thirty (30) feet on each side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Nineteen (19) in Township Three (3) North Range Twenty-eight (28) East W.M.

Beginning at Station 277-78 of the Butter Creek Highway Survey which Station is approximately 1220 feet north of the Section corner which is common to sections Nineteen (19) Twenty (20) , Twenty-nine (29) and Thirty (30) in Township Three (3) North Range Twenty-eight (28) East W.M.; Thence S 19° 18' West approximately 1285 feet to Station 290x63 of the said Survey, which Station is approximately 460 feet west of the section corner, which is common to sections Nineteen, (19), Twenty (20), Twenty-nine (29) and Thirty (30) in Township three (3) North Range Twenty-eight (28) East W.M., Containing 1.78 acres more or less.

The grantee herein, as a part of the consideration aforesaid, promises and agrees to build a good substantial fence on each side of the said strip of land or right of way.

from one end there of to the other, and properly connect the said fence at each said end, and on each said side, with the present boundary line fences of the said real property through which said right of way is granted, etc., and to build the same as soon as the said road is constructed, without any expense whatever to the grantors herein and, also said grantee as a part of said consideration, further promises and agrees to replace, or reconstruct in a good substantial manner any irrigation ditch, or ditches, with which it may interfere in the construction of said highway, and without damage to the grantors herein.
