Township 3 North, Range 28 East W. M., said center line being more particularly described as follows; Beginning at the quarter corner common to Sections 28 and 29, Township 3 North Range 28 East, W. M. thence in a westerly direction along the center line of said Section 29 approximately one fourth mile to the Northeast corner of the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of said Section 29, Township 3 North, Range 28 East W. M.

To Have and to Hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
