That portion of the Nancy Kennedy estate in the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section Two (2), Township five (5) North, Range Thirty-five (35) E.W.M., required for a right of way for the Oregon Washington Highway as surveyed across said property, more particularly described as follows: Commencing at a point in the existing County Road which point is 1215.8 feet south and 54.1 feet west of the quarter corner between Section 2, Township 5 North, Range 35 E.
