IN THE MATTER OF OREGON ROAD,

KNOWN AS THE PENDLETON-DESPAIN GULCH HIGHWAY,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Robert L. Jones and Velma E. Jones, his wife, Pauline Jones Kay and James R. Kay, her husband and Minna Belle VanEaton and Frank W. VanEaton, her husband, of the County of Umatilla in the State of Oregon, in consideration of the benefits and other valuable considerations, and the sum of One dollar paid them, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit:

A strip of land 60 feet wide being 30' on each side of the center line as stated over and across a portion of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 53, Twp. 3 N. R. 32 E. W. M. Beginning at a point known and designated as Station 8/ 67 point on a 16° curve to the right whose tangent at that point bears N 42° 38' W. Said point being 102 feet South and 801 feet East of the center of Sec 53, Twp. 3 N. R. 32 E. W. M., running thence on a 16° curve to the right a distance of 200.7 feet; thence North 9° 34' West, a distance of 219.2 feet; thence on a 10° curve to the right a distance of 156.7; thence North 6° 06' E. 92.8 feet; thence on 22° C.R. a distance of 297.7 feet; thence North 71° 36' East a distance of 310.7; thence on a 12° curve to the left 262.5 feet; thence North 41° 06' East a distance of 1623.8 feet; thence on a 6° 30' curve left a distance of 400.2 feet to a point known and designated as Station 43/ 71, point on a 6° 30' curve whose tangent at that point bears North 15° 06' East. Said point being approximately 31 feet due West of the section corner common to Sections 27, 28, 53 and 54, Twp. 3 North Range 32, E. W. M.

Said parcel of land containing 4.91 acres more or less.

Also a parcel of land in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 27, Township 3 N. R. 32 E. W. M. described as follows: Beginning at the Section corner common to Sections 27, 28, 53 and 54 Township 3 North Range 32 E. W. M., thence due North 2640 feet; thence due East 50 feet; thence due South 2420 feet to a line parallel and 30 feet; East of a 6° 30' curve a distance of 221 feet to place of beginning. Containing 1.62 acres more or less.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, to the purpose of a public road forever.
