of the County of Umatilla, in the State of Oregon, in consideration of the benefits and other valuable considerations, and the sum of One Dollar paid them, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit: A strip of land Sixty (60) feet wide, being Thirty (30) feet on each side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across

The Southwest Quarter (S.W. 1/4) of Section 2 Township 4 North Range 31 East W. M. Beginning at Station 802 + 63 of the Pendleton Cold Springs Highway Survey which Station is approximately 1098 feet West of the Center Section 2 Township 4 North Range 31 East W. M. Thence running in a Southeasterly direction approximately 1697 feet to Station 819 + 60 of the said survey, which Station is approximately 1277 feet South of the Center Section 2 Township 4 North Range 31 East W.M.

On Here and in Hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever. Center line at Station 803 + 30 to be 22 feet to the right of the present fence
