THAT THE PARTY OF THE FIRST PART, for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter mentioned, to be kept and performed by said party of the second part, its assigns and successors, has leased and does hereby lease and let unto the party of the second part all these premises lying and being in Umatilla County, State of Oregon, described as follows: to-wit;

all that part of the property of James Bottger in the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 15, Township 3 North, Range 29 East of Willamette Meridian, said parcel of land being more Particularly described as follows:
