Beginning at Station 35 / 62.0 of the said Highway Survey which station is approximately 564 feet North of the 1/4 Section Corner which is common to Sections 27 and 28 Township 2 North Range 32 East W.M. Thence running in a Northwesterly direction approximately 942.8 feet to station 45 / 04.8 of the said survey, which Station is approximately 1295 feet North and 596.3 feet West of the 1/4 Section corner which is common to sections 27 and 28 Township 2 North Range 32 East W.M.
