Range 30 East W.M. Beginning at a point of the Oregon-Washington Highway Survey which Station is approximately 1387 feet North of the 1/4 Corner which is common to Sections 24 - 25 Township 1 South, Range 30 East W.M. Thence running in a Northeasterly direction approximately 5425 feet to Station 227 x 25 of the said survey, which Station is approximately 310 feet North of the East 1/4 corner Section 24 Township 1 South Range 30 E.W.M., Said parcel of land containing 4.72 acres, more or less.

We Have and to Hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
