sioners on December 18, 1985, at the
hour of 10:15 A.M., in Room 114 of the
Umatilla County Courthouse in Pen-
dleton, OR, for the purpose of consid-
ering the vacation of Meadow Valley
County Road in Umatilla County,
being more particularly described as
follows:

Meadow Valley County Road is in the
SE 1/4 of Section 25, T4N R27
E.W.M., n the SE 1/4 of Tax Lot
1403.

Centerline Description for Vacation
beginning at a point on the north-
erly right-of-way line of I-84 Engi-
neer Station 917+41.3, said point
being 332.3 feet north and 1073.58
feet west of the SE corner of
Section 25, T4N, R27 E.W.M.;
Thence, N24°34'30"E 997.4 feet to a
point at right angles to and 81.0
feet, westerly from Engineer Sta-
tion "MV" 5°91.61, said point being
1239.33 feet north and 658.79 feet
west of said section corner.

The vacation is 25 feet each side of
the above described centerline.
